# Little Red Feather grows from Singletary's success

Billy Koch's partnership group has A-list clients, widening focus five years after launch

**F**IVE years ago, Billy Koch struggled to find takers when he asked just about everyone he knew to join his new syndicate, Little Red Feather Racing, in Southern California.

One of three horses in Koch's second partnership turned out to be Singletary, who incited a raucous celebration at Lone Star Park in 2004 when he won the \$1,540,560 NetJets Breeders' Cup Mile (G1).

Today, Little Red Feather has reached its 29th partnership, and its clients now include New York Mets catcher Paul Lo Duca, New England Patriots quarterback Tom Brady, ESPN broadcaster Kenny Mayne, and rapper Jay-Z.

The group made a conspicuous debut at Saratoga Race Course in August when Cleveland Cavaliers all-star forward LeBron James accompanied his business manager, Little Red Feather partner Maverick Carter, to watch Guts Game run in an optional claiming race for New York-breds.

"I have a great picture of LeBron and [jockey] Kent Desormeaux," Koch said on September 24. "It was the craziest day I've ever had. We're trying to get these guys in and get them to the track, because it's great for racing. They don't have a concept of how badly racing needs this kind of thing."

Koch has made a staggering climb in a short period from hitting up his friends to rubbing shoulders with A-list clients, but he still exudes a very broad passion for the racing industry that stems from his childhood. Koch is the grandson of Howard W. Koch, who raced horses and was a prominent Hollywood producer and director.

"In the old days, that's why they called it Hollywood Park, because it was all Hollywood people," Koch said. "My grandfather was a big-time Hollywood producer, and all of his buddies would go to the track on the weekends or if they had a horse running. They would leave movie sets to go watch the races."

## Seed planted

As a child, Koch's favorite horse was Telly's Pop, a four-time graded stakes winner whom his grandfather owned in the mid-1970s with actor Telly Savalas.

"They have pictures of me at the races when I was five and six years old with flowers around my neck," Koch said. "All my clothes were blue and white like our silks, and I couldn't sleep the night before his races. It's kind of like I've been an owner since I was six years old. I've gotten to experience this adren-

aline rush that you get at the track before, during, and after the race that, if you could bottle it, you'd be a billionaire. Really, that's what it's all about."

Not surprisingly, Koch places an emphasis on the live racing experi-

ence for his clients, which has molded Little Red Feather's expansion to the East Coast over the last year.

The stable currently has 18 horses in training, and eight of them are divided among trainers David Duggan

at Belmont Park, John Servis at Philadelphia Park, and Marty Wolfson at Calder Race Course.

"My goal is to get people to the track," Koch said. "That's the only way to get people excited about horse racing. I realized that people who invest in a horse in California that live in New York, it just doesn't work out that well. People who live in New York want to go to the track there, and I want them to go to the track there and see their horses and feel what's going on. There is so much energy when you go to the track and see your horse run. It becomes tangible."

One of Little Red Feather's investors in Philadelphia and New York is Bob Brittingham, who was one of the five partners in the Cash is King stable that raced 2005 champion three-year-old male and dual classic winner Afleet Alex.

Brittingham met Koch and some of the other Singletary partners at the 2004 Breeders' Cup at Lone Star. Singletary's victory came the same day Afleet Alex finished second in the Bessemer Trust Breeders' Cup Juvenile (G1).

"I still remember and they still show it [on TVG] most of

## Rome burns with enthusiasm over Little Red Feather winner

ENTHUSIASM poured through the radio on October 1 when, despite a busy sports weekend, nationally syndicated sports talk host Jim Rome talked about Thoroughbred ownership on his show.

As a member of Little Red Feather Racing, Rome owns part of Wing Forward (Arg), who won his North American racing debut two days earlier. The three-year-old Arch colt rallied from last in the field of 12 to win a

one-mile turf allowance race by a neck at Oak Tree at Santa Anita Park at odds of 14.50-to-1.

"It was one of the most amazing experiences I've ever had," Rome told his listeners. Rome, who has offered more horse racing coverage on his radio show than most national hosts, said he has considered horse ownership for years.

Billy Koch, managing partner of Little Red Feather, approached Rome about Wing Forward, and the host

of "The Jungle" took the plunge.

"It's something I've always wanted to do," Rome said. "I talked it over with my wife, Janet, and she was enthusiastic about doing this." Koch joined Rome on the show, and the two talked about the joys of winning a Thoroughbred race. "Because it's so tough to win, any time you win it's exciting," said Koch, whose Little Red Feather Racing campaigned 2004 NetJets Breeders' Cup Mile (G1) winner Singletary. "You get that feeling every single time."

Rome said he thoroughly enjoyed the day of racing, especially walking into the paddock, meeting the other syndicate owners, trainer Mike Puype,

and jockey Jose Valdivia Jr. He admitted to having some doubts when Wing Forward was last through a half-mile in :48.05.

Always a fan of horse racing, Rome has joked over the years about it being more of a gambling venture than a sport. His mind has changed. "I really had an epiphany," Rome said. "It's such a great experience. I was all fired up."

Koch credited Puype with discovering the horse in Argentina, where he finished second in his debut and won his second start. He also credited Puype's patience as a key for Wing Forward's successful North American debut.—Frank Angst

"I love their enthusiasm about the sport. A couple of friends of mine had asked me about going in on some horses, and Billy and Little Red Feather were perfect.

"With [Aleet Alex's success], we got more into the breeding side of things," Brittingham continued. "I'm busy with that, and my wife owns two real estate companies, so I'm busy helping her. I didn't need [to deal with] the day-to-day operations of running horses. Billy is a perfect communi-

cator. I get e-mails from him every day, every hour. I talk to him probably five days a week. I love his enthusiasm, love his youth."

### Full-time work

Singletary's success allowed Koch to devote full-time attention to Little Red Feather. He had followed his grandfather and father into the movie business, working in visual effects and for an online production company, but his heart was at the racetrack.

Koch brought in a high school friend, entertainment lawyer Gary Fenton, to oversee Little Red Feather's business operations. At this point, Fenton and Koch are the stable's only employees, but that will probably change with another round

of regional expansion.

Koch is planning to have horses and clients in Toronto and Chicago in 2008.

"In Toronto especially, with the purses there and me having some connections in that market, I just think it's a nice opportunity to bring our product there," he said. "I've been approached by a couple people in Chicago who have groups that would like to get involved, so we're going to go there and kind of set it up. We've had a great experience in Philadelphia in that we went in and set it up and bought the horses and got everyone together and now we're having

a good time watching them run. That's the whole point of this.

"Needless to say, we haven't duplicated the success we had with Singletary, and I put a 'yet' in there because we're going to keep trying, and we're going to have a lot of fun doing it." ♦
